



**Special Call Council Meeting

**City Council met this date with all members present except for Councilperson Norman, Mayor Gist, and Mayor Pro Tem Durham. Manager Lee Bailey, City Clerk Courtney Greene, and City Attorney Terry Clark were also in attendance. Notice of the meeting was sent to the media the week prior to the meeting and posted on the bulletin board at City Hall in advance according to the Freedom of Information Act.**

- I. **Call to Order** – The meeting was called to order at approximately 4:30 pm. Since both the mayor and may pro tem were absent, the council had to elect a presiding officer for that meeting. Council voted to elect Councilperson Sloan as presiding officer of that meeting. The vote was unanimous. Presiding Officer Sloan asked for a motion to approve the agenda for the September 13, 2016 special call meeting. A motion was made by councilperson Kennedy and a second was made by councilperson Smith. The vote was unanimous.
  
- II. **Old Business-**
  - A. **Second Reading to Approve an Ordinance Providing for the Issuance and Sale of a \$6,546,000 Sewer System Revenue Bond, Series 2016, of the City of Woodruff, South Carolina, for the Expenditure of the Proceeds Thereof, for the Payment Said Bonds, and Other Matters Relating Thereto-** City Manager came forward and stated that no changes had been made since the first reading. He stated that everything was still on schedule to close as planned. Presiding officer Sloan asked for a motion to approve the second reading of the ordinance Providing for the Issuance and Sale of a \$6,546,000 Sewer System Revenue Bond, Series 2016, of the City of Woodruff, South Carolina, for the Expenditure of the Proceeds Thereof, for the Payment Said Bonds, and Other Matters Relating Thereto.
