The City of Woodruff has been monitoring the COVID -19 pandemic very closely. The safety and well being for our citizens, businesses and city staff is paramount.

With the closure of all school districts across the State, City officials have implemented several changes in the daily operations and how the City will respond to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. Below are the actions the City will be taking to keep our citizens safe.

City Operations- Through April 6, 2020

- **Public access to all City facilities is being limited.** The majority of business for sewer payments, new customers, business license, and building permits shall be conducted thru the video monitor and teller tube located in the reception area of City Hall.
- **McKinney Park playground equipment is scheduled to be sanitized.** We will also be cleaning them on a scheduled basis during the next few months.
- **All McKinney park and auditorium rentals are canceled until April 6, 2020.** McKinney park and open-air recreation space will remain open at this time.
- **Public Safety** operations will continue as normal- however firefighters and police officers may take additional precautions to ensure safety.
- The **Public Works** department will continue as normal. Trash service will continue on the normal schedule until further notice.
- **Sewer Payments** can be paid on line, over the phone in lieu of the payment tube located at City Hall.
- **Municipal Court** has been canceled until further notice. If you were scheduled for Woodruff Municipal Court you will be contacted with your new court date.
- The March 24, 2020 Public Hearing and Council meeting will continue as planned. We encourage citizens that **ONLY** has business on the agenda or public hearing to attend the meeting.

Public Recommendations

- Please limit public gatherings to a small group of 10 people or less.
