

U.S. Highway 221 Force Main Replacement  
Woodruff, South Carolina

Sealed bids will be received by the City of Woodruff, SC, on Tuesday, February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019 until 2:00 p.m., EST, for construction of the U.S. Highway 221 Force Main Replacement Project, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Woodruff City Hall, 231 E. Hayne Street, Woodruff, SC 29388.

Bids must be submitted on the complete project and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed to Lee Bailey, 231 E. Hayne Street, Woodruff, SC 29388. Outside of the envelope must be marked "Bid for U.S. Highway 221 Force Main Replacement". Envelope must also bear, on the outside, the name of the bidder, bidder's address, and bidder's license number. All bids must be made on blank forms provided and included in the bound document or as provided by Addendum prior to bid.

Any questions, clarifications, or RFI's shall be submitted to Engineer no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup>. All questions shall be submitted by email to bidding coordinator Kara Hrkach (khrkach@hmwengineers.com).

The work is as follows:

The project generally consists of the abandonment of a portion of an existing 12" sanitary sewer force main and installation of a proposed 16" sanitary sewer force main.

A Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an accepted Surety, in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total of the Bid shall be submitted with each bid.

The City of Woodruff reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informalities or technicalities in the bidding, or to re-advertise at their discretion.

Bids may be held by the City of Woodruff for a period not to exceed 90 days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.

This project is being funded in whole or in part by the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). All federal CDBG requirements will apply to the contract. All contractors and subcontractors are required to be registered in the federal System for Award Management (SAM). Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 & Order No. 11375 which prohibits discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex, or national origin. Bidders must comply with Title VI if the Civil Rights Act of

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1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and 40 CFR 33.240.

Bidders must also make positive efforts to use small and minority-owned business and to offer employment, training and contracting opportunities in accordance with Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968. Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

All bidders are advised that the application with cost estimate is available for review. The owner reserves the right to waive any irregularities, or to reject any or all bids. No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
