City Council met on this date with Council members Kelley, Sloan, Arnold, Norman, Wood, Durham and the Mayor Gist present. City Manager Lee Bailey City Attorney Terry Clark and City Clerk Bekki Phillips were also present. Notice of the meeting was sent to the media prior to the meeting and posted on the bulletin board at City Hall in advance of the meeting according to the Freedom of Information Act.

- I. **Call to Order-** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Gist at 5:25 p.m.
- II. **Public Comment as Related to the Zoning of Three Tracts of Land I-2 Heavy Industrial Tax Map # 4-24-00-020.02, 4-24-0-020.01, 4-24-00-020.00 Located at 6400 Highway 101, 6410 Highway 101 Heavy Upon Annexation.** Mr. Roy Engelhardt signed up to speak. Mayor asked that Mr. Engelhardt approach the podium. Mr. Engelhardt stated that he lives in the Crescent area off Cooper Bridge Rd. He stated that he has concerns about safety due to the heavy flow of traffic inside the city. He also stated that it is now easier for him to take his business outside the city than to try and manage his big truck and trailer around town. He also stated that the back roads are now getting congested as well. Mr. Engelhardt asked Mayor and council how they are going to tackle the traffic issues in town. Mr. Engelhardt again stated that his major concern is safety. Mayor thanked Mr. Engelhardt for his comments.
